Decision Making Process at the tactical level

AIM

The aim of the course is to enable the students to apply the military decision making procedures in accordance with NATO standards throughout the full spectrum of conflicts in multinational environment.

Security Classification:

Target Audience:

Senior NCOs and Officers.

Training Strategy:

Tuition is conducted daily through lectures, presentations, syndicate discussions, exercises and individual private study (self-study) aimed deepening the knowledge.

There are 6 hours planned daily (1 teaching unit lasts for 50 minutes). The time after lessons is reserved for individual private study (IPS), consultation activities and students' preparation. Students are divided into syndicates, 10 students each. Education and training is led by ISOC Instructors and Guest Speakers from NATO and the Slovak Armed Forces. It is a blended course with the duration not more than 3 weeks. The number of iterations per year is in accordance to the need.
