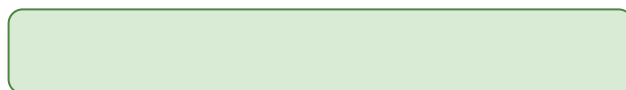


Figure 1 Title of figure (11 pt)
